The records show that Gosper Rymer, private, Company B, 7th Regiment Florida Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted March 28, 1862. He was captured at Cassville, Georgia, May 20 or 21, 1864. His name appears on a roll of prisoners of war at Rock Island Barracks, Illinois, as enlisted in the United States Navy and transferred June 10, 1864. No later record of him has been found in this Department.
