

# Widow's Pension Claim

UNDER THE ACT OF 1909

On this *26* day of *July*, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred and *nine*, personally appeared before me, a *CLC et al* in and for the County and State aforesaid, *Emily E Waldron* a resident of *Lake City* County of *Columbia* State of Florida, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain a pension under the provisions of Chapter 5885 Laws of Florida, approved June 7, 1909.

That she is the widow of *J. C. Waldron* who was enlisted under the name of *J. C. Waldron* on the *5th* day of *March*, 186*1*, in Company *B* *5th* Regiment of the State of *Fla* and who was honorably discharged at *Elmira New York*, 186*5*, on account of *AWM*

That he also served.....

*He was in prison at Elmira N. Y. until about June 1865*

That she was lawfully married to the said *J. C. Waldron* under the name of *Emily E. Adams* in the County of *Hutton* State of *Ga* on the *16* day of *Dec*, 18*56* and that she was not divorced from him and that she has not remarried since his death, which occurred on the *5* day of *July*, 18*95*, in the County of *Columbia* State of *Florida*

That she is a resident of *Columbia* County, Florida, and has continuously resided in the State of Florida since the *in* day of *April*, 18*57*
